

Incoming Mobility Managed by the Faculty of Medicine of Nice

The International Relations Office of the Faculty of Medicine of Nice exclusively accepts and manages student mobility (study or internship) for students whose home institution has signed :

- an International Framework Agreement, or
- a bilateral Erasmus Agreement (Europe)

with the Faculty of Medicine of Nice and Université Côte d'Azur.

The mobility will be academically validated by the Faculty.

Here are the documents the student will have to send me by email :

- resume (CV)
- covering letter (letter of motivation)
- Proof of registration in your Faculty
- Passport
- Student card
- Health insurance for France
- Professional liability insurance for internship in France

Internships Managed by the University Hospital (CHU)

Internships must last less than two months and must be unpaid observational internships.

1/ Observational internships (excluding Erasmus)

Observational internships are managed by the CHU.

2/ Erasmus+ Internships

Under certain conditions and subject to availability, Erasmus+ internships may be accepted by the CHU on a case-by-case basis.

The main requirement is that the internship must be fully and exclusively supervised and validated by the CHU. It will therefore be a hospital internship, not a university/faculty internship.

Please note: the Faculty of Medicine cannot provide any academic validation, signature, or official stamp for these internships.

Permanent Transfers

1/ Students residing in France wishing to permanently transfer to the Faculty of Medicine of Nice

- Students wishing to enter the first year of medical studies must apply through Parcoursup.
- No enrolment is possible during the course of a degree cycle.
- For enrolment in M1, please contact the administrative office of the second cycle and the M1 programme coordinator.

2/ Students residing in Europe or outside Europe

Permanent transfers are not possible.
